WHEREAS, the theme for the convention: "Kamusta ka? The Mental Well-Being of Women Judges as a Key to Efficiency and Resilience" is timely and relevant after more than two (2) years of pandemic;

WHEREAS, the nine (9) judges of the Regional Trial Court of Pasig City who will be attending the said convention/seminar sought for financial assistance from the City Government of Pasig for their participation in the said convention/seminar;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig acknowledges the indispensable role of the Judiciary, and deems it meritorious to hereby grant financial assistance to them in the amount of Eight Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 8,500.00) each to help defray the cost of their participation in the said convention/seminar;

Mr. Presiding Officer and Members of the 11th Sangguniang Panlungsod Committee on Peace & Order, Human Rights, Judicial Matters and Anti-Drug Abuse respectfully presents & renders the Committee Report on the Committee hearing conducted last February 20,2023 at the Gallery Hall of Session Hall, 7th floor Pasig City Hall.

The Committee Reports:

The Pasig City Regional Trial Court Women Judges headed by Executive Judge Maria Gracia Cadiz-Casaclang requested financial assistance to the City Government of Pasig to help defray their expenses on their participation to the Seminar Convention on Conrad Pasay City.

Executive Judge Casaclang mentioned to the committee that only nine (9) out of the eleven (11) judges will attend the said seminar convention as the other two has a prior commitment on the said days. The said seminar is not about legal or jurisprudence but will tackle their mental health which is essential as Judges, they must have a stable emotional control as they are dealing with decisions in the court and such participation to the said convention can help them enhance their mental health.

Executive Judge Casaclang clarified that the difference of their request with the request of the Women Judges of the Metropolitan Trial Court of Pasig is that they opted to pay the registration on site which makes their requested assistance Php.500.000 higher.

Committee Chairperson delos Santos and the members of the council unanimously expressed their support for the grant of the said amount and that they appreciate their efforts serving the courts in the City of Pasig.

Summary of Discussion

- There are only nine. (9) out of eleven (11) women judges from the Pasig Regional Trial Court (RTC) that will attend the said seminar convention.
- The said Seminar Convention is entitles Kamusta ka? Which is all about tackling their mental health.
- The request of the lady judges from the RTC is higher than the request of the METC judges as they opted to pay on site.
