WHEREAS, the Philippine Women Judges Association (PWJA) will be holding a seminar/convention at the Conrad Hotel, Pasay City on March 20 to 22, 2023, with "Mental Well-Being of Women Judges" as its central theme;

WHEREAS, judges of the Metropolitan Trial Court of Pasig City who will be attending the said seminar/convention sought for financial assistance from the City Government of Pasig for their participation in the said event;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig acknowledges the indispensable role of judges in their administration of justice, and deems it meritorious to hereby grant financial assistance in the amount of Eight Thousand Pesos (Php 8,000.00) to each Metropolitan Trial Court Judge to help defray the cost of their registration in the said convention;

NOW, THEREFORE, on session duly assembled, the Sangguniang Panlungsod, resolves, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize the Honorable City Mayor Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto, to grant financial assistance in the amount of Eight Thousand Pesos (Php 8,000.00) each to two (2) Metropolitan Trial Court (Metc) Judges, to help defray the cost of their registration in the Philippine Women Judges Association (PWJA) Seminar-Convention to be held on March 20 to 22, 2023 at the Conrad Hotel, Pasay City.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that the budgetary requirement to implement this Resolution shall be chargeable against any available funds in the City Treasury, subject to existing COA rules and regulations.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Secretary of the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall furnish all concerned agencies/offices copies of this Resolution, as duly adopted/approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

Mr. Presiding Officer and Members of the 11th Sangguniang Panlungsod the Committee on Peace & Order, Human Rights, Judicial Matters and Anti-Drug Abuse respectfully presents & renders the Committee Report on the Committee hearing conducted last February 20,2023 at the Gallery Hall of Session Hall, 7th floor Pasig City Hall.

The Committee Reports that:

Committee Chairperson delos Santos acknowledged the presence of Hon. Bethany V. Conde-Punzalan, Presiding Judge of the Metropolitan Trial Court (METC) Pasig City.

Honorable Judge Conde-Punzalan was given the floor to manifest her inputs in regards to the proposed resolution that will grant financial assistance to their participation to the Seminar-Convention that will occur in Conrad Hotel Pasay City on March 20-22,2023.

Honorable Judge Conde-Punzalan manifested that out of the four (4) Women Judges in the Metropolitan Trial Court (METC) Pasig City, only two (2) of them will attend the said seminar convention. The said registration fee amounting to Php. 8,000 pesos is for the early bird rate.

It was clarified by the Committee Chairperson that the requested amount is P22,200.00 or P11,100.00 foreach of the participants. He said that they will inquire from the City Administrator`s office as to the request forwarded.

Summary of Discussion:

- Only two (2) of the four (4) Honorable Female Judges of the Metropolitan Trial Court (METC) Pasig City will attend the Seminar Convention.
- The Php. 8,000 registration fee that they requested is for the early bird registration.


