A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE ~~IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 451,000.00), WHICH WILL BE DIVIDED PROPORTIONATELY AMONG THE FORTY-ONE (41) PROSECUTORS OF PASIG CITY, IN ORDER TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF ITS PARTICIPATION IN THE MANDATORY CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION CONVENTION FOR ALL PROSECUTORS AND LAWYERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR THE 8TH COMPLIANCE PERIOD ON JULY 10-14, 2023 AT THE MANILA HOTEL, ERMITA, MANILA, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.~~

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice ("DOJ") is mandated by law to provide the government with a principal law agency which shall be both its legal counsel and prosecution arm, administer the criminal justice system through the investigation of crimes, prosecution of offenders and administration of the correctional system, implement the laws on the admission and stay of aliens, citizenship, land titling system, and settlement of land problems involving small landowners and members of indigenous cultural minorities, and provide free legal services to indigent members of the society;

WHEREAS, Bar Matter No. 850 requires all members of the Integrated Bar of the Philippines, including DOJ prosecutors and lawyers, to undergo Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE);

WHEREAS, the DOJ will conduct its first MCLE Convention for all DOJ prosecutors and lawyers for the 8th Compliance Period, with the first leg to be conducted this July 10- 14, 2023 at the Manila Hotel, Ermita, Manila, for prosecutors stationed within the National Capital Region (NCR) and lawyers of the DOJ Proper;

WHEREAS, the MCLE Convention will focus on subjects vital to prosecutorial functions and updates on law and jurisprudence ensuring that our prosecutors will be equipped in their effective and efficient delivery of service to the public;

WHEREAS, due to the high number of prosecutors and DOJ lawyers, including those working and living in Pasig City, expected to attend the said MCLE Convention, financial assistance is sought in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Pesos (Php 451,000.00), where each and every prosecutor of Pasig City will receive proportionately an amount of Eleven Thousand Pesos (Php11,000.00) to defray the cost of their participation in the said MCLE Convention;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig remains supportive to the training and development of its local prosecutors and deems it meritorious to extend financial assistance to them in order to help defray the cost of their participation in the said convention;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod resolves, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto, to grant financial assistance to the Department of Justice, in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Pesos (Php 451,000.00), which will be divided proportionately among the forty-one (41) prosecutors of Pasig City, in order to defray the cost of its participation in the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education Convention for all DOJ Prosecutors and Lawyers for the 8th Compliance Period on July 10-14, 2023, at the Manila Hotel, Ermita, Manila.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that the budgetary requirement to implement this Resolution shall be chargeable against any available funds in the City Treasury, subject to existing COA rules and regulations.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Secretary of the Sangguniang Panlungsod furnish all concerned agencies/offices copies of this Resolution, as duly adopted/approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

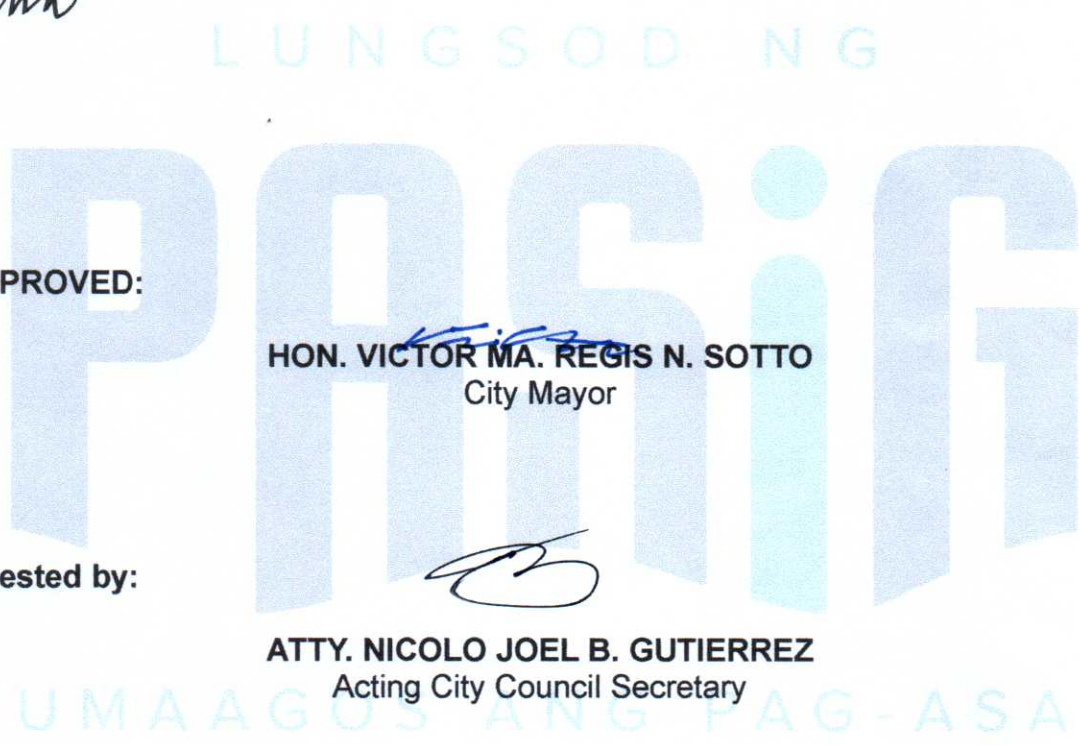

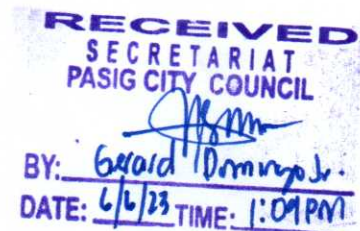

COMMITTEE REPORT ON: ON PROPOSED RESOLUTION 273-2023: A Resolution Authorizing the City Mayor Honorable Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto, to Grant Financial Assistance to the Department of Justice in the Amount of Four Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Pesos (Php 451,000.00), Which Will be Divided Proportionately Among the Forty-One (41) Prosecutors of Pasig City, In Order to Help Defray the Cost of Its Participation in the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education Convention for All Prosecutors and Lawyers of the Department of Justice for the *th Compliance Period on July 10-14, 2023 at the Manila Hotel, Ermita, Manila, and for other Purposes

Mr. Presiding Officer and Members of the 11th Sangguniang Panlungsod the Committee on Laws Rules and Internal Government respectfully presents & submits the Committee Report on Proposed Resolution 273 - 2023.

The Committee Respectfully Reports:

1. The Pasig City Prosecutor's Office appealed before and to the Committee on Peace and Order, Human Rights, Judicial Matters and anti-drug Abuse the grant of the financial assistance amounting to Four Hundred Fifty-One

Thousand Pesos (Php 451,000.00) for the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) convention to be held by the Department of Justice on July 10-14, 2023 at The Manila Hotel, Ermita, Manila.

2. The said financial assistance shall be divided proportionately among the forty-one (41) prosecutors of Pasig City who will be attending the said convention in order to help defray their participation costs.
3. The Pasig City Prosecutor's Office explained and extended through Chief City Prosecutor Atty. Rey Camilo B. Dumlao II the importance and purpose of the MCLE, that is to keep all the lawyers abreast with the law and jurisprudence as well as to maintain the ethics of their profession and enhance the standards of the practice of law.
4. Further, it was explained that the compliance to MCLE every three (3) years is important and mandatory to the lawyers due to the fact that they cannot practice without such compliance as the MCLE effectively provides them the personality to appear before any court in the country through the compliance number or MCLE number provided by the Integrated Bar of the Philippines (IBP) upon compliance to MCLE.
5. It was also expressed that shared bookings in The Manila Hotel have already been reserved by the prosecutors in order to incur lesser costs. The amount for the accommodation expenses alone that will be accounted to each prosecutor will be twelve thousand pesos (Php 12,000.00).
6. The Committee clarified and maintained that the said amount of Four Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Pesos (Php 451,000.00) is indeed City Government Of Pasig's personal financial assistance to its city prosecutors and not to the DOJ as pursuant to the letter sent by the Secretary of Justice to the Office of the City Mayor informing the office about the MCLE convention.
7. The Committee recommends the approval of the proposed resolution to be duly passed on the next regular or special session of the 11th Sanggunian to be held on the following day, June 06, 2023.
