WHEREAS, the Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council has formulated, discussed, and updated the Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan for Calendar Years 2023-2028, as required by Section 12, (c)(6) of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations under Rule 6, Section 4(7);

WHEREAS, the 2017-2022 Pasig Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan was revisited and updated by the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and found to be satisfactory and sufficient to address the various aspects of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management for the protection. safety, needs, and aspirations of the people of Pasig City;

WHEREAS, as a dynamic and progressive development plan suited to the City's vision on disaster resilience, it is subject to periodical revisions and/or enrichment of resources, as warranted:

WHEREAS, on 22 May 2023, the Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management issued Resolution No. 1, Series of 2023 to approve the Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan 2023-2028 and efficiency endorse the same for adoption of the Sangguniang Panlungsod;

With majority members present and resource persons, Committee on Disaster Resilience conducted its Committee hearing .

Anchored on Resolution # 1 Series of 2023 duly approved by Pasig City Disaster Risk and Reduction Management Council concerning the Pasig City Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan for 2023-2028, the Chair, Coun. Agustin opened the discussion and presented the Proposed Resolution No. 271-2023 for recommendation to adopt.

There were very important inquiries and points raised related thereto and the following were considered salient points;

- A. Chairman Coun. Agustin asked what were the DRR MANAGEMENT PLAN 2023-2028 all about and DRRMO-Chief Wong answered;
 - a. The Plan, contained in 300 pages more or less, was the updated version of 2022. For 2023, PCDRRM Council enhanced and further formulate the Plan for 6 years which were found satisfactory and sufficient to address the aspects of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management for the protection, safety, and aspirations of Pasigueño.
 - b. The Consultant, Ms. Vidar presented the vision and target. She highlighted that not only Pasig should be ready for the 7.2 magnitude or the Big One, but the "preparedness" should engage all partners in the detailed planning, a lot in monitoring the disaster and aim for zero casualties= zero death in which the potential source were public schools, temporary shelter/houses of ISF and those living along flood prone areas.
 - c. Mr. Wong emphasized that the DRRM Plan always linked to the broader plans of the City, namely the CLWUP and the CDP and to the national priorities set in the NDRRMP and horizontally aligned with other sectoral and thematic plans of the LGU.

It had organized Plan to include;

- <u>Risk Profile</u> which drawn from various studies, such as the Climate and Disaster Risk Assessment (CDRA), which followed the guidelines set by the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD, and the account available risk assessments commissioned by the PCDRRMO.
- 2) <u>Situational Analysis</u> related to the four thematic areas of disaster risk reduction, namely disaster preparedness, response, prevention and mitigation, and recovery. Strength-Weakness-Opportunities-Challenges (SWOC) conducted and the result laid down the targets for the next six years. It contained the goals, objectives, outcomes, programs, projects, activities, gender concerns, key outputs, responsible offices, and estimated timeframe and sources of funds.

help that they could extend. And he stressed that we should help one another; conduct exercises to be aware and discussed everything; coordinate activities and conduct seminars, drills to improve, spread the words of preparedness and be pro-active.

Mr. Wong responded about the Contingency Plan for flood, Marikina willing to help and for trainings and support, assistance may also be sought from Region 2. And, if by land or by sea, help and assistance from NGO.

- i. Coun Rustia inquired the availability of potable water during this situation and to consider water from Ilog Pasig as source because we had only one (1) dam for almost 22M individuals and it could not support them.
 Mr. Wong responded that for Ilog Pasig, river water could be made potable drinking water. DRRMO had 4 units of water filtration that can create thousands of liters, and could also purify about the level of salt water but requires lot of filters. However, it did not have a place to put the filtration machine at District 1.
 Ilog Pasig as source of potable water should be pursued.
- j. As discussion progresses, Chairman Agustin asked the possibility to have solar energy for light and be provided to ISF, some source of energy for filtration machine for clean water and other useful energy for ISF per household.
 Mr. Wong said that he is not sure about that but it will be taken and consider as urgent matter.

Lastly, the DRRMO and City Planning Office were reminded about the E-Copy of Pasig City Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan for 2023-2028, be provided to City Councilors for review as well as Zoning Map of risk prone and critical areas and be shared to other departments in preparation and readiness for the Big One.

Provided further, for effective dissemination of information down to barangay /constituents, copies be also available to them and down loadable thru Pasig City website/platform.

IV. RECOMMENDATIONS:

After due considerations of the measure, the recommendations;

- Committee on Disaster Resilience adopted the Proposed Resolution No. 721-2023 in its entirety and with no amendments.
- 2. And, to pursue the approval for 2nd Reading in the next Regular Session.

There being no more matters to discuss, meeting was adjourned 6:00 pm


