A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF PASIG THROUGH THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, VICTOR MA REGIS N. SOTTO, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH PREMIER 101 HEALTHCARE MANAGEMENT, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL AND ANCILLARY SERVICES TO THE PATIENTS OF PASIG CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL AND PASIG CITY CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL - CHILD'S HOPE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7610, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of health services including access to secondary and tertiary health services;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the foregoing mandate, the City Government of Pasig runs the Pasig City General Hospital (PCGH), and the Pasig City Children's Hospital - Child's Hope (PCCH), both of which are Tertiary Level Hospitals;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig assists in defraying the costs of medical expenses incurred by the patients of PCGH and PCCH through the Medical Assistance for Indigent Patients (MAIP) Program of the Department of Health;

WHEREAS, the MAIP Program provide support for drugs, medicines, medical/orthopedic devices, dental services, or other medically related needs prescribed by the physician of a health facility for in-patients and out-patients, in excess of the packages/case rates covered by PhilHealth or other financing sources subject to the availability of funds;


WHEREAS, PCGH and PCCH have inherent limitations as regards their capacity to meet the demand for their clinical, ancillary, and diagnostic services, and are not able to fully provide for all the healthcare needs of their patients at all times;

WHEREAS, to facilitate continuity of care and ensure the best possible health outcome for their clients, there is a need to refer patients and clients of PCGH and PCCH to other health care facilities that are capable of providing the needed medical and ancillary services;

WHEREAS, Premier 101 Healthcare Management, Inc., is a Joint Venture partner of the City Government of Pasig in the operation and management of the Pasig City Megadialysis Center. has the capability and resources to provide services such as, but not limited to, the following: Hemodialysis Treatment, Laboratory Works, and Pharmaceutical/Medicine provision for patients' needs, that are identified as needed by the referred patients;

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WHEREAS, the Premier 101 Healthcare Management, Inc. has indicated its willingness to partner with the City Government of Pasig in augmenting the needs of patients who are eligible as MAIP beneficiaries, but who cannot be accommodated by the PCGH or the PCCH;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PASIG CITY COUNCIL IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize the Honorable City Mayor, Victor Ma Regis N. Sotto, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with Premier 101 Healthcare Management, Inc. for the provision of medical and ancillary services to the patients of Pasig City General Hospital and Pasig City Children's Hospital - Child's Hope.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that copies of the Memorandum of Agreement shall form an integral part of this Resolution;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Secretary of the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall furnish all concerned agencies/offices copies of this Resolution, as duly adopted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

The Committee on Health, Sanitation and Nutrition conducted a Committee Hearing on June 29, 2023, 10:00 o'clock in the morning at the Gallery, Session Hall, 7/F Pasig Cityhall, to discuss the pertinent provisions of Proposed Resolution No. 298-2023, entitled: "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF PASIG THROUGH THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH PREMIER 101 HEALTHCARE MANAGEMENT INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL AND ANCILLARY SERVICES TO THE PATIENTS OF PASIG CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL AND PASIG CITY CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL-CHILD'S HOPE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

The City Government of Pasig, through the Medical Assistance for Indigent Patients (MAIP) provided by the Department of Health, assists in defraying the cost of medical expenses incurred by indigent patients of Pasig City General Hospital and Pasig City Children's Hospital.

The MAIP program of the DOH provide support for drugs, medicines, medical/orthopedic devices, dental services or other medically related needs prescribed by the physician of a health facility for in-patient and out-patients in excess of the packages/case rates covered by Philhealth or other financing sources subject to the availability of funds.

PCGH and PCCH have inherent limitations as regards their capacity to meet the demand for their clinical, ancillary, and diagnostic services, and are not able to fully provide for all the healthcare needs of their patients at all times.

To facilitate continuity of care and ensure the best possible health outcome for their clients, there is a need to refer patients and clients of PCGH and PCCH to other health care facilities that are capable of providing the needed medical and ancillary services.

Premier 101 Healthcare Management Inc. has been a partner of the City Government in several health services provided by the City and they are capable to meet the needs of patients referred to them.

Premier 101, through its Chief of Operations, Mr. Philip Lim, assures the Councilors that they will extend the best possible services they can give to serve the constituents of Pasig. According to Mr. Lim there are about 186 registered dialysis patient as of this date but they can accommodate more. That 186 patients is about 2,200 sessions per month.

Premier 101's goal is to accommodate as high as 700 registered dialysis patient to augment the services provided by the City's own dialysis facilities. In cases where PCCH, PCGH or our own dialysis facilities cannot accommodate dialysis patient, our health facilities can refer patients to Premier 101 for treatment.

The Committee recommended that this Resolution be passed on second reading on the next regular or special session of the Sanggunian.


