WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the Katarungang Pambarangay or the Barangay Justice System is a community-based dispute settlement mechanism that is administered by the barangay through the guidance of the Punong Barangay and the Lupong Tagapamayapa;

WHEREAS, the establishment and operation of the Katarungang Pambarangay is mandated by the Local Government Code of 1991 that seeks to promote the speedy administration of justice, relieve courts of docket congestion caused by indiscriminate filing of cases, and to perpetuate and recognize the tradition of amicably settling disputes at the community level;

WHEREAS, to institutionalize a system of granting economic benefits and incentives for the effective implementation of the Katarungang Pambarangay, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) launched the Lupong Tagapamayapa Incentives Awards in 1997. COMMITTEE REPORT
Committee on Appropriations, Ways and Means

The initial hearing was held on July 4, 2023 at the Session Hall, 7th Floor, Pasig City Hall, in the presence of majority of the members of the Committee on Appropriations, Ways, and Means, Hon. Paul Roman C. Santiago with Ms. Visitacion Martinez, CESO V and Mr. Carlo Tristan Vinta from the DILG Pasig Field Office, Ms. Cecile S. Blas from the Barangay Affairs / Community Relation and Information Office, and Ms. Jamine E. Castañeda from the Accounting Office to discuss **Proposed Resolution No. 323-2023** titled **A Resolution Authorizing The City Mayor, Hon. Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto To Grant Cash Prize And Incentives In The Amount Of Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (PHP 950,000.00) To The Winners Of Lupon Tagapamayapa Incentives Awards That Was Conducted By The Department Of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Pasig City Field Office As Recognition To Lupon Tagapamayapa That Demonstrated Exemplary Performance In Settling Disputes In Barangay Level For The Year 2023, And For Other Purposes**, which was referred to the Committee during the Regular Session held July 3, 2023

After a careful study and discussion, the following were finalized:

1. Committee Chairperson inquired on how the awards are given. Ms. Martinez explained that PHP 150,000 for the 1st place, PHP 75,000 for 2nd place, PHP 37,500 for 3rd place and an incentive of 20,000 for every participating barangay as support of the LGU to the operations of the *Katarungang Pambarangay*.
2. Ms. Martinez explained the process of deliberation for awards, *Lupon* are required to submit their documents, and are put on shortlists for on-site validation. DILG also ensures 100% participation by requiring all thirty barangays are subject to the same.
3. Ms. Blas manifested that there has been an improvement with the performance and mediation capability of the *Lupon*, citing that there has been less complaints regarding the *Lupon*.
4. Barangay Dela Paz had won for three consecutive years, and is a contender for winning at the regional and national levels.
5. Committee Chairperson manifested that there should be continuous capacity-building with *Lupon*.

In view of the discussion, the Committee on Appropriations, Ways, and Means recommends that this report be adopted, and **Proposed Resolution No. 323-2023** be passed on its second reading in the next regular or special session.
