SOTTO, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH - TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTER BICUTAN, FOR THE PROVISION OF ASSISTANCE TO FIRST TIME INDIGENT DRUG DEPENDENTS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 75 of Republic Act No. 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, provides that the management, operation, and maintenance of all government treatment and rehabilitation facilities were transferred to the Department of Health (DOH);

WHEREAS, the 11th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Pasig passed Resolution No. 119-11, Series of 2023, entitled "A Resolution Authorizing The City Government of Pasig, Through The Honorable City Mayor Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto, To Enter Into And Sign A Memorandum Of Agreement With The Department Of Health-Treatment And Rehabilitation Center Bicutan For The Provision Of Assistance To First Time Indigent Drug Dependents, And For Other Purposes", last May 31, 2023;

WHEREAS, in the previous Resolution passed, the cost-sharing rate of the City Government of Pasig with DOH Bicutan is monthly cost sharing rate per admitted first time drug dependent/patient in the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred (Php 26,500.00) for a fixed period of seven (7) months and Five Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (Php 5,400.00) for three (3) months for an intensive aftercare program shall be shouldered by the City Government of Pasig;

WHEREAS, upon coordination with the DOH- Treatment & Rehabilitation Center Bicutan, there has been a recent adjustment to the monthly cost-sharing rate. The new rate will now amount to Fifty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 52,500.00) for a fixed period of seven (7) months, or Php 7,500.00 per month, and Five Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (Php 5,400.00) for the cost of three (3) month extensive aftercare program to be shouldered by the City Government of Pasig;





The Committee Respectfully Reports:

Discussion

1. The City Council of Pasig initiates to amend and increase the amount of contribution or monthly cost-sharing rate per admitted first time drug dependent patient from the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred (Php26,500.00) for a fixed period of seven (7) months and Five Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (Php 5,400.00) for three (3) months for an intensive aftercare program to a new amount and rate of Fifty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php. 52,500.00) for a fixed period of seven (7) months, or Php. 7,500.00 per month, and Five Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (Php.5,400.00) for the cost of three (3) month extensive aftercare program to be shouldered by the City Government of Pasig.
2. The said amount to be shouldered by the City Government of Pasig includes food, accommodation or dormitories, and all other pertinent expenses.
3. The City Administrator informed that they will first acquire a draft from Pasig City Anti Drug Abuse Office (PCADAO) to be scheduled with the Mayor's Office for signing.
4. The Budget Office clarified that there is an allocated budget for the whole year 2023 for the provision of the said assistance in the amount of 2.3 Million Pesos.

Recommendation

5. Majority Floor Leader Councilor Mark Gil "Volta" delos Santos further moved for the amendment of the said resolution to include all the present councilors during the committee hearing, namely, Hon. Raymund Francis M. Rustia, Hon. Paul Roman Santiago, Hon. Roderick Mario Gonzales and Hon. Noel Agustin.
6. The committee recommends that the proposed resolution be approved on the next regular session.




