WHEREAS, it is recommended that graduating elementary students with highest honors (gold), with high honors (silver), and with honors (bronze) receive Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000.00), One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 1,500.00), and One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00) each respectively, in recognition of their remarkable achievements and performance both in academic and non-academic areas:

WHEREAS, it is further recommended that graduating senior high school students with highest honors (gold), with high honors (silver), and with honors bronze) will receive Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 3,500.00), Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00), and One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 1,500.00) each respectively, in recognition of their remarkable achievements and performance both in academic and non-academic areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod resolves, as it hereby resolved, to authorize the Honorable City Mayor Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto to grant additional cash incentives to graduating students of Forty-Four (44) Public High School and Elementary Schools in Pasig City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the budgetary requirement to implement this resolution shall be chargeable against any available funds in the City Treasury subject to existing COA rules and regulations.

COMMITTEE REPORT

Committee on Appropriations, Ways and Means

The initial hearing was held on July 21, 2023 at the Session Hall, 7th Floor, Pasig City Hall, in the presence of majority of the members of the Committee on Appropriations, Ways, and Means, jointly with the Committee on Education, with Atty. Kathleen Villamin from the Education Unit to discuss Proposed Resolution No. 334-2023 titled A Resolution Authorizing The Honorable City Mayor, Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto To Grant Additional Cash Incentive To The Graduating Students With Honors From Forty-Four (44) Public High School And Elementary Schools In Pasig City, And For Other Purposes which was referred to the Committee during the Regular Session held July 17, 2023.

After a careful study and discussion, the following were finalized:

- 1. The Proposed Resolution merits an increase in incentive amount by PHP 500 for all awardees.
- 2. Atty. Kathleen presented figures of graduating honor students, based on medal count. The education unit estimates 6,294 honor students amounting to around PHP 10,388,500.00
- Amendments were proposed to edit the title and body of the Resolution to include a clause directing
 the Sanggunian Secretariat to furnish a copy of the adopted resolution to all concerned
 departments/offices.

In view of the discussion, the Committee on Appropriations, Ways, and Means and the Committee on Education recommends that this report be adopted, and Proposed Resolution No. 334-2023 titled A Resolution Authorizing The Honorable City Mayor, Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto To Grant Additional Cash Incentive To The Graduating Students With Honors From Forty-Four (44) Public High School And Elementary Schools In Pasig City, And For Other Purposes be passed on its second reading in the next regular or special session.
