A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF PASIG, THROUGH THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, VICTOR MA REGIS N. SOTTO, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MULTI-YEAR CONTRACT FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE PASIG CITY SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOOD PLAN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, there is a need for the City Government of Pasig to formulate a comprehensive Pasig City Sustainable Livelihood Plan which will provide a long-term strategy to serve as a guide for the City for the succeeding three (3) years, aimed to uplift the local constituency and bridge the gaps between the provision of skills training, and success through gainful employment, upskilling, and entrepreneurship;

WHEREAS, the Sustainable Livelihood Plan envisions to attain the following major objectives:

- a. **Maintain and Update the City Local Economic Database:** Assist in updating a database that can be accessed by economic and planning offices in Pasig City, including economic-based statistics. The goals of the same should be: (i) To track economic data as well as track the status and development of economic players such as skilled workers/entrepreneurs/job-seekers/vocational and technical students in the City; (ii) To make available for use data on the economic statistics such as unemployment and enterprise registration; and (iii) To check progress on participants of the Program;
- b. **Plan for Continuous Business Development Programs within the Locality:** Assist in creating a prepared business learning and development syllabus which will contain modules on Marketing, Operations Management, Financial Literacy, Relevant laws and regulations, Product Development, Gender Advocacy, etc;
- c. **Identify and Plan Initiatives for Job Facilitation and Upskilling:** Assess the status quo with regard to job facilitation as well as technical vocational upskilling, and recommend practical and time-based initiatives to improve local government programs with regard to these;
- d. **Identify and Plan Initiatives for Further Cooperatives Development:** Assess the current situation of cooperatives in the locality, and map potential stakeholders through the analysis of existing rules and regulations regarding cooperatives. Analyze the needs and gaps for the development of these cooperatives, and provide support, technical knowledge, and a road map for setting up of cooperatives for other stakeholders;

e. **Review and Recommend Programs for Aid for Startups:** Recommend financing opportunities for stakeholders, especially those start-up enterprises and/or marginalized sector participants, either through the creation of homegrown programs or through partnerships with third-party financial agencies to grow the network; and

f. **Prepare a Plan for the Development of the Informal Economy into Legitimization and Economic Growth:** Include as stakeholder and beneficiary not only members of the informal economy, but also those from the various marginalized sectors such as PWDs, seniors, LGBTQI, women, etc;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Government, through the City Mayor, to enter into a multi-year contract for those projects with a recurring nature or with multi-year implementation not indicated in the Executive Budget, subject to the provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, or the Government Procurement Reform Act, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and other relevant Government Procurement Policy Board guidelines;
