

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. PCG-001 SERIES OF 2022

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER PLACING THE CITY OF PASIG UNDER GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE ALERT LEVEL 3 FROM 03 JANUARY UNTIL 15 JANUARY 2022

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), since having been declared as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC), has irreversibly affected millions of lives and families worldwide. Its unprecedented speed of transmission and infectivity has placed a huge burden on essential area of governance, most importantly in vulnerable sectors such as the economy, education, and healthcare;

WHEREAS, Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among its constituents;

WHEREAS, Section 2 (b) of Executive Order No. 168, Series 2014 mandates the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) to prevent and/or minimize the entry of suspected or confirmed patients with emerging infectious diseases into the country;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH), the University of the Philippines-Philippine Genome Center (UP-PGC), and the University of the Philippines-National Institute of Health (UP-NIH) biosurveillance have detected B.1.1.7 (Alpha), B.1.351 (Beta), P.1 (Gamma), and B.1.617 (Delta) variants of SARS-CoV-2 in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, with a new B.1.1.529 variant designated as a Variant of Concern and named Omicron, proactive measures and restrictions must be put in place;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases passed Resolution No. 155, Series of 2021 dated 31 December 2021, which escalated the alert level classification of the National Capital Region (NCR) to Alert Level 3 effective 03 January 2022 until 15 January 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO, Mayor of Pasig City, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF IATF RESOLUTION NO. 155 (S. 2021). – The City Government of Pasig adopts the guidelines on the implementation of Alert Level System 3 in the National Capital Region from 03 January 2022 until 15 January 2022.



SECTION 2. INTRAZONAL AND INTERZONAL TRAVEL FOR MINORS, SENIOR CITIZENS, AND THOSE WITH COMMORBIDITIES. – Intrazonal and interzonal travel shall be allowed. Those below eighteen (18) years of age, and those belonging to the vulnerable population, shall be allowed access to obtain essential goods and services, or for work in permitted industries and offices in accordance with existing labor laws, rules, and regulations.

SECTION 3. INDIVIDUAL OUTDOOR EXERCISES. – Individual outdoor exercises shall be allowed for all ages regardless of comorbidities or vaccination status.

SECTION 4. ESTABLISHMENTS AND/OR ACTIVITIES NOT ALLOWED TO OPERATE OR BE UNDERTAKEN. – The following establishments and/or activities characterized as high-risk for transmission shall not be allowed to operate, or be undertaken in areas classified under Alert Level 3:

- Face to face or in-person classes for basic education, except those previously approved by the IATF and/or the Office of the President;
- b. Contact sports, except those conducted under a bubble-type setup as provided for under relevant guidelines adopted by the IATF, Games and Amusement Board, and Philippine Sports Commission, and approved by the LGU where such games shall be held;
- c. Funfairs/peryas and kid amusement industries such as playgrounds, playroom, and kiddie rides;
- d. Venues with live voice or wind-instrument performers and audiences such as in karaoke bars, clubs, concert halls, and theaters;
- Horse racing, cockfighting and operation of cockpits, lottery and betting shops, and other gaming establishments except as may be authorized by the IATF or the Office of the President; and
- f. Gatherings in residences with individuals not belonging to the same household.

SECTION 5. ESTABLISHMENTS AND/OR ACTIVITIES ALLOWED TO OPERATE OR BE UNDERTAKEN. – The following establishments, or activities, shall be allowed to operate or be undertaken at a maximum of 30% indoor venue capacity for fully vaccinated individuals only and 50% outdoor venue capacity. Provided that all on-site workers/employees of these establishments, and organizers of activities are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and the





Minimum Public Health Standards (MPHS) shall be strictly maintained. Provided further, that there is no objection from the LGU where these activities may take place:

- a. Venues for meetings, incentives, conferences, and exhibitions (MICE);
- Permitted venues for social events such as parties, wedding receptions, engagement parties, wedding anniversaries, debut and birthday parties, family reunions, and bridal or baby showers;
- Visitor or tourist attractions such as libraries, archives, museums, galleries, exhibits, parks, plazas, public gardens, scenic viewpoints or overlooks, and the like;
- d. Amusement parks or theme parks;
- e. Recreational venues such as internet cafes, billiard halls, amusement arcades, bowling alleys, skating rinks, archery halls, swimming pools, and similar venues;
- Cinemas and movie houses;
- g. Limited face-to-face or in-person classes for higher education and for technicalvocational education and training;
- In-person religious gatherings; gatherings for necrological services, wakes, inurnment, and funerals for those who died of causes other than COVID-19 and for the cremains of the COVID-19 deceased;
- Licensure or entrance/qualifying examinations administered by their respective government agency, and specialty examinations authorized by the IATF subject to the health and safety guidelines as approved by the IATF;
- j. Dine-in services in food preparation establishments such as kiosks, commissaries, restaurants, and eateries, subject to DTI sector-specific protocols;
- k. Personal care establishments such as barbershops, hair spas, hair salons, and nail spas, and those offering aesthetic/cosmetic services or procedures, make-up services, salons, spas, reflexology, and other similar procedures including home service options, subject to the sector-specific protocols of the DTI;



- I. Fitness studios, gyms, and venues for non-contact exercise and sports, subject to DTI sector-specific protocols. Provided that patrons/clients and workers/employees wear face masks at all times and that no group activities are conducted; and
- m. Film, music, and television production, subject to the joint guidelines as may be issued by the DTI, DOLE, and the DOH.

SECTION 6. SAFETY SEAL CERTIFICATION. – Business establishments are allowed additional venue/seating capacity of ten percent (10%) beyond the existing allowable venue/seating capacity if said business establishments have been awarded Safety Seal Certification (DOLE-DOH-DILG-DOT-DTI Joint Memorandum Circular No. 21-01, Series of 2021).

SECTION 7. ALTERNATIVE WORK ARRANGEMENTS (AWA) FOR CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICES/DEPARTMENTS. – Under Alert Level System 3, all services of the City Governments shall be operational, subject to the following work capacities of the following City Government offices/departments:

a) Full Operational Capacity

All City Government offices/departments primarily engaged in medical, peace and order, vaccination program, City Census Program, business permit renewal, ayuda distribution efforts of the City, and disaster response shall remain to be fully operational, such as but not limited to, the City Health Department (CHD), all City-run hospitals, Peace and Order Department (POD), Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (DRRMO), and all its related divisions and offices.

In addition to these offices, the following Departments and Offices shall also be fully operational:

b) 60% Operational Capacity

All other departments and offices of the City Government are mandated to operate at a sixty percent (60%) on-site capacity.

These Departments and Offices are hereby ordered to submit their Personnel Complement Schedule indicating those individuals who shall report to work on-site during the allowed days.

c) The City Mayor Reserves the right to require any department, office, unit, or employee to report physically to work, when needed.

SECTION 8. CONTINUED EFFECTIVITY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT POLICIES. – All COVID-19 related issuances, executive orders, and policies of the City Government of Pasig, insofar as they are not in contradiction to the mandates this EO or of the national government, such as curfew hours, allowed activities, and allowed individual movements, shall continue to subsist and be implemented with full effect. The force and effectivity of the same will be without prejudice to any further changes in the mandates of the local or national government.

SECTION 9. DISSEMINATION. – Copies of this Executive Order shall be furnished within seventy-two (72) hours from its issuance to the Office of the President and the Department of Health for their information and guidance.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval and shall remain in effect for the entirety of Alert Level Systems 3.
