

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. PCG <u>55</u> SERIES OF 2022

AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE LOCAL HOUSING BOARD OF PASIG CITY, EXPANDING THE MEMBERS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 54, Series of 2020 established the Pasig City Socialized Housing and Urban Community Development Program with the purpose of formulation, planning, design, and implementation of socialized housing and resettlement plans, programs, and activities in accordance with the State's continuing program of urban land reform and housing to provide safe, secure, decent, resilient and affordable housing and basic services to poor and underprivileged in our city;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Article II of Ordinance No. 54, Series of 2020 created the City's Local Housing Board tasked to formulate, develop, implement, and monitor policies on the provision on housing and resettlement areas, and on the observance of the right of the underprivileged and homeless to a just and humane eviction and demolition;

WHEREAS, Section 4.2 of Article II of Ordinance No. 54, Series of 2020, provides that the Local Housing Board shall be composed of, among others, representatives from the People's Organization who are duly recognized by the city, or by other national entities whose number shall not be less than one-fourth of the full membership of the Board and at least two (2) representatives from the Non-Government Organizations who are duly accredited or recognized by the city, or by other national entities;

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Pasig Urban Settlements Office, there is a need to expand the composition of the City's Local Housing Board to include additional members from various homeowners' association within the City's jurisdiction and accredited Civil Society Organization or People's Organization with proven record of engagement with both national and local government agencies on housing and related issues, and has long been recognized as a civil society organization or people's organization under the National Registry of Accredited of Civil Society Organization;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO, Mayor of the City of Pasig, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby order the reconstitution of the Local Housing Board:

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. — All other orders or issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. — This Order shall take effect immediately.
